In the world, book reading is considered a new cultural practice of social anthropology, and its analysis is carried out on the basis of historical gradualism. Also, reading a book is defined as an indicator of socio-cultural process. Independent companies, state and social organizations, research centers (Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development, Asian Information and Analysis Fund) are actively participating in this process. In particular, in a 2004 study conducted by the US National Endowment for the Arts (NEA), it was emphasized that prevention of a

sharp decline in the level of "reading works of art" by young people is a nationwide problem. .

Globally, there is a growing need to develop clear guidelines for preparing students for social life. It is becoming one of the important issues to restore their emotional activity, mental and physical strength and work ability through reading books. A number of scientific researches are being carried out on the development of the book and its use technologies in the development of the social activity of the students, and the formation of the culture of reading and reading in the family. It is especially important to improve the socio-pedagogical mechanisms of developing students' reading skills, to clarify the pedagogical-psychological factors of the formation of interest in reading. Also, in terms of informatization of education, the development of virtual technologies for the development of students' reading skills, and the formation of information consumption culture by working with electronic educational literature are of great relevance.

In our republic, special importance is attached to the development of students' reading skills, the formation of a reading culture in them, and the formation of a reading culture in students based on a systematic approach. Ishaqkhan Ibrat's library served not only the students he taught, but also the villagers. The books in the library are divided into several sections according to their character and direction. In particular, the section intended for school teachers includes textbooks and training manuals such as "Master First" by S. Saidazizov, "The First Teacher" by Abdulla Avloni, "Turkish Gulistan or Ethics", "Rahbari Shil" by R. Yusufbek Haji Ogle. Ibrat's library was constantly enriched. The enlightener personally supervised the establishment of library activities, the keeping of notebooks recording the receipt and delivery of books by readers, as well as the reading and reading of books by students [55].

Unfortunately, there are quite a few people who spend their valuable time playing idle entertainment games instead of reading books. Such people show their lack of spirituality in their thinking and behavior. We are living in the age of technology, day by day technical tools are developing and the need for them is increasing. In particular, we can use mobile phones, various internet systems as an example. It's true, wide opportunities are being created for young people in our country. Because it is the youth who raise the honor of our nation and our national pride. Therefore, like the youth of different nations and peoples, Uzbek youth should communicate with the world. In Uzbekistan, it is also a modern form of social propaganda
